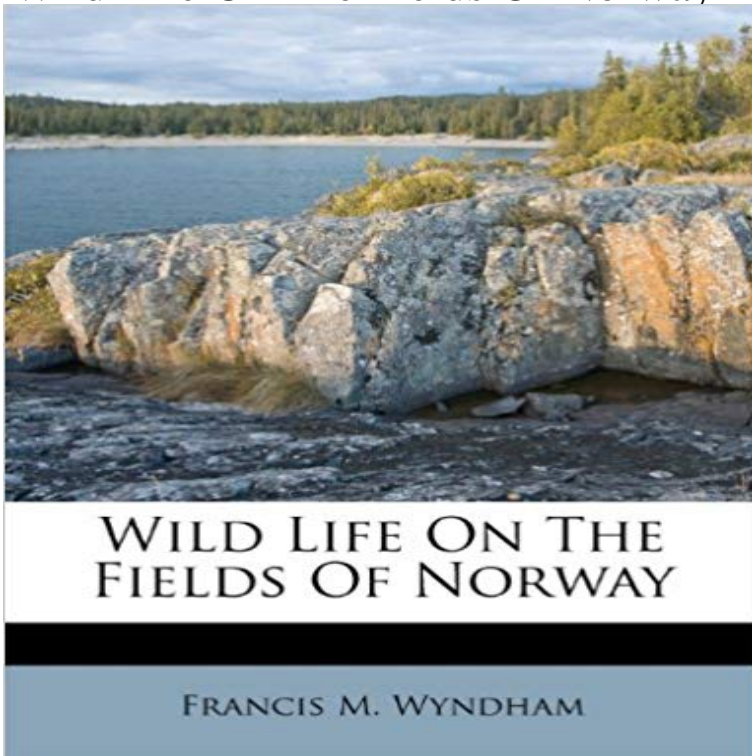


Wild Life On The Fields Of Norway
