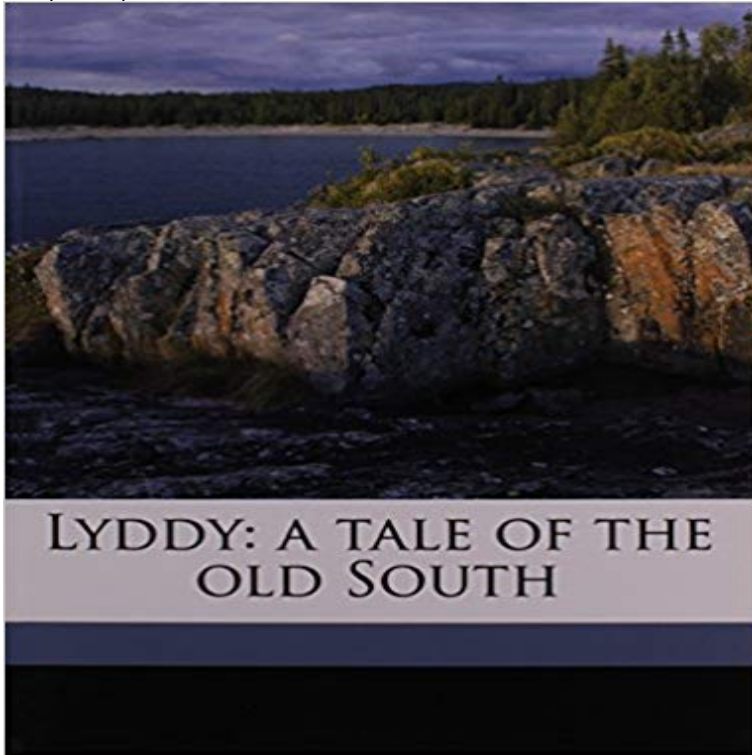


## Lyddy: a tale of the old South
