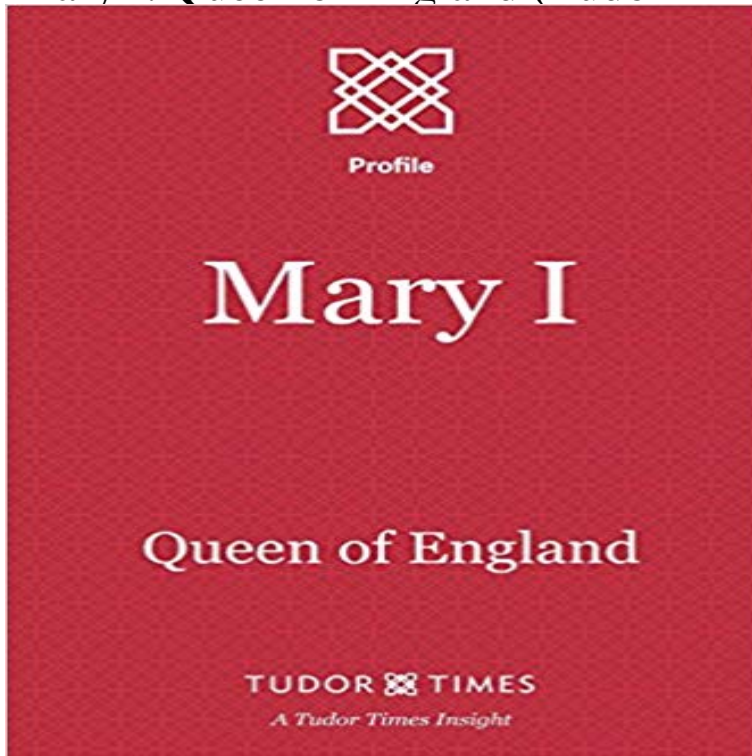


Mary I: Queen of England (Tudor Times Insights (Profiles)) (Volume 14)
