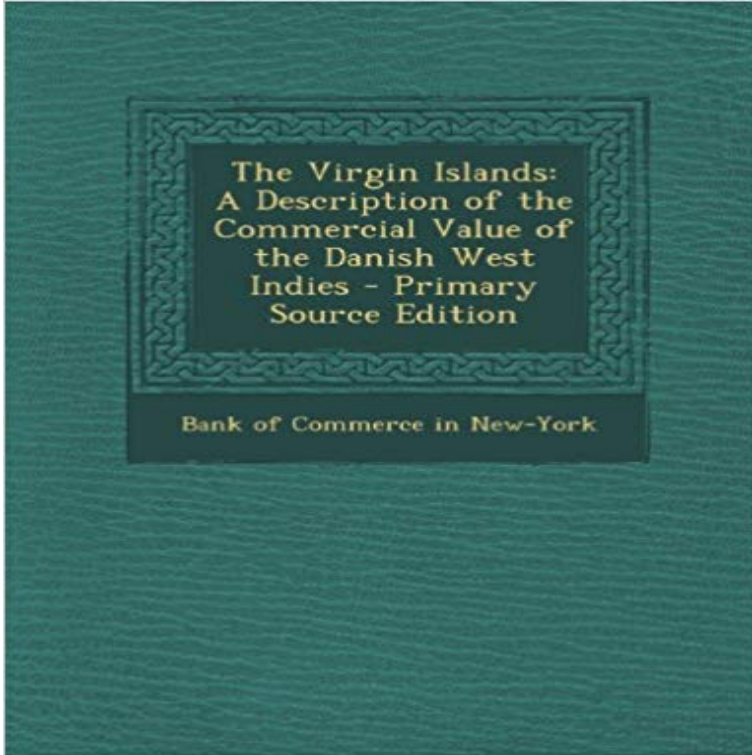


The Virgin Islands: A Description of the Commercial Value of the Danish West Indies
