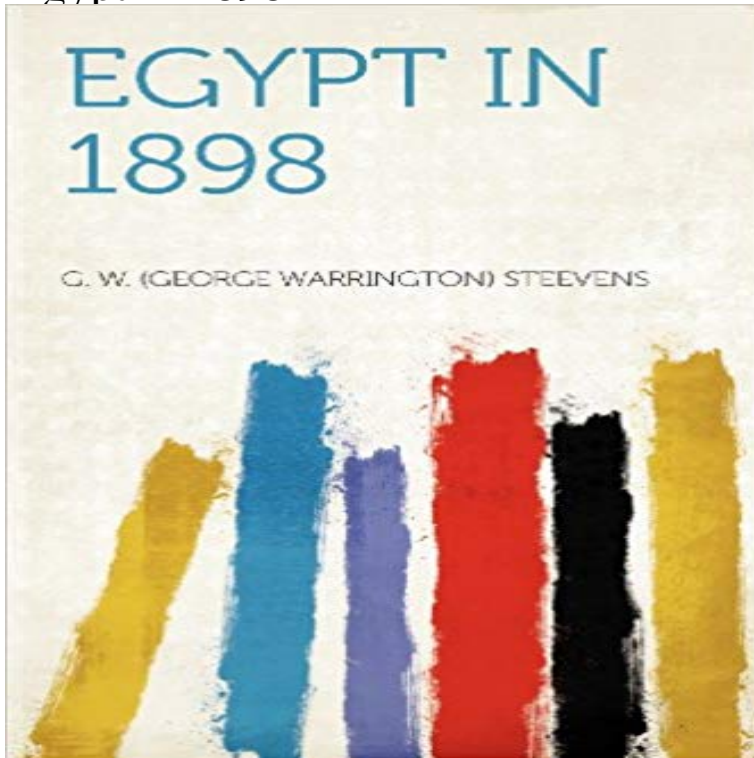


## Egypt in 1898
