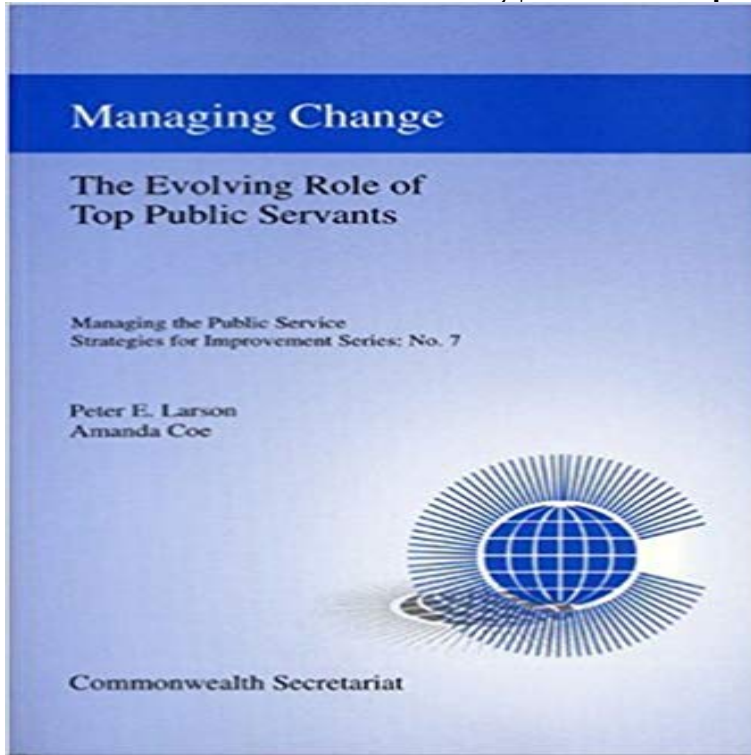


# Managing Change: Changing the Role of Top Public Servants (Managing the Public Service: Strategies for Improvement Series)
