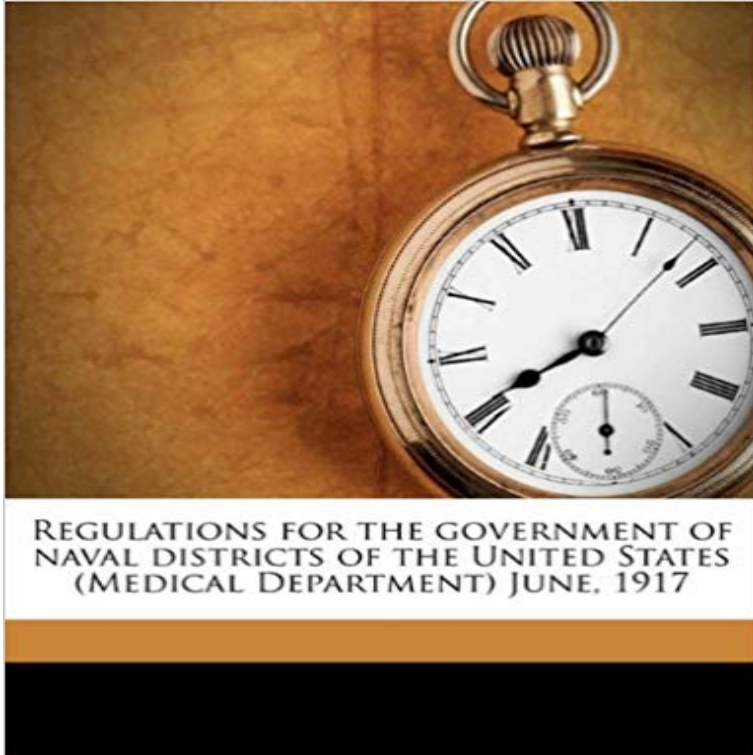


Regulations for the government of naval districts of the United States (Medical Department) June, 1917
