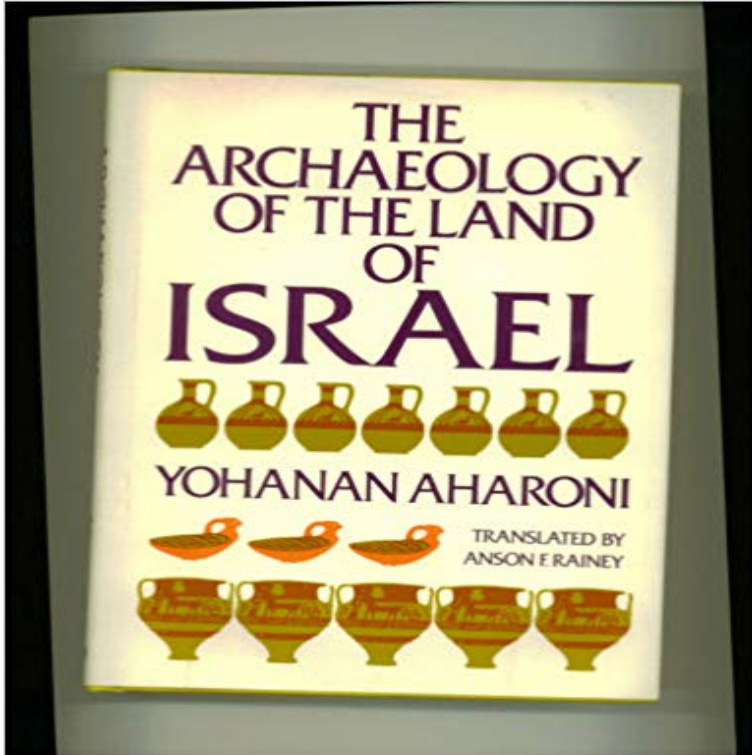


The archaeology of the land of Israel: From the prehistoric beginnings to the end of the First Temple period
