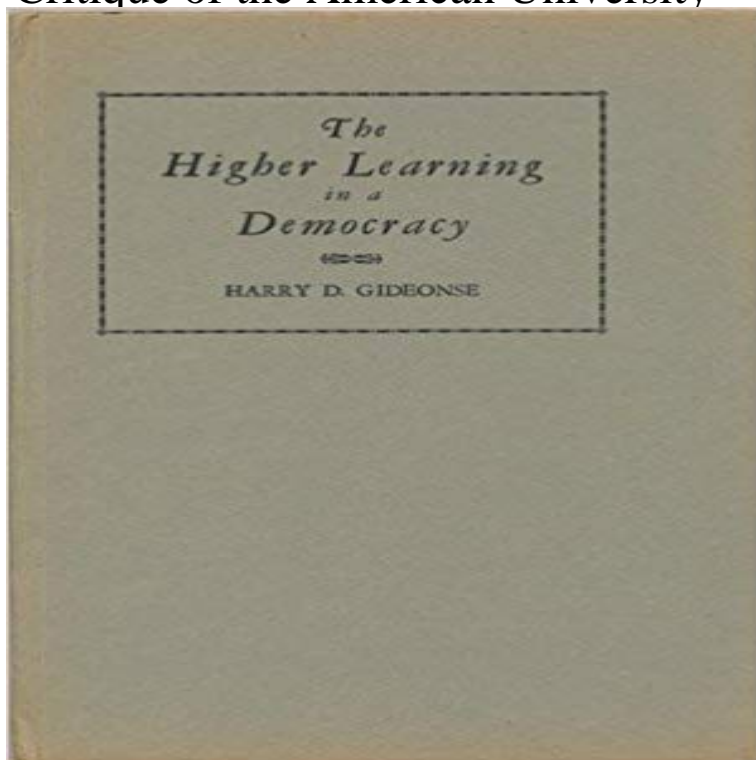


The Higher Learning in a Democracy. A Reply to President Hutchins Critique of the American University



Hutchins urged an immersion in metaphysics, or the area of knowledge that draws out the basic principles and causes underlying our world. Gideonse attached Hutchins argument as being inherently elitist, reactionary and anti-democratic.
