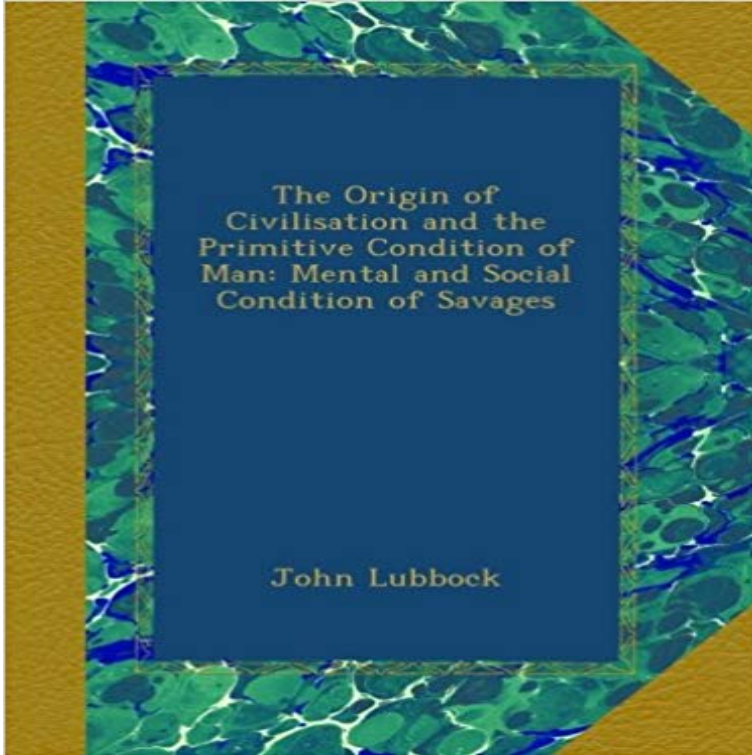


# The Origin of Civilisation and the Primitive Condition of Man: Mental and Social Condition of Savages
