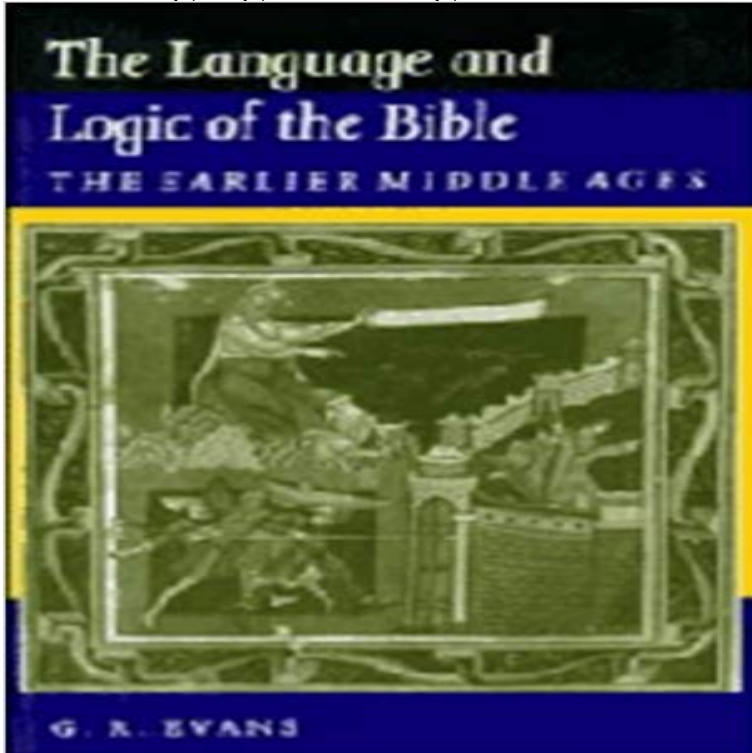


## The Language and Logic of the Bible: The Earlier Middle Ages
